#### Ministerial Review of the FRIP

on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> May the CARICOM Framework Regional Integration Policy on Public Procurement (FRIP) was reviewed at the 32<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the Council for Trade and Economic Development, in Georgetown, Guyana.

#### Ministerial Review of the FRIP

The COTED was asked to approve the policy and also to gave instructions for the drafting of the Protocol to amend the Revised Treaty of Chaguaramas.

## Ministerial Approval of the FRIP

adopted the CARICOM Framework Regional Integration Policy on Public Procurement (FRIP) in its Fourth Draft which reflected the recommended amendments to the Third Draft with the understanding that the threshold values and list of excluded entities would be included when agreed;

## Ministerial Approval of the FRIP

<u>authorised</u> the drafting of the Protocol to amend the Revised Treaty of Chaguaramas based on the Fourth Draft of the FRIP;

# Ministerial Approval of the FRIP

<u>agreed</u> to the formation of a Task Force which would be responsible for developing proposals on the implementation of the various dimensions of the framework policy; and

#### Belize

- Agreed to Thresholds for Goods, Services and Works
- Provided list of Excluded entities
- Approved the FRIP in its entirety
