#### GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

The Caribbean Community (CARICOM) Secretariat has received a grant from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) in an amount equivalent to US\$508,502 towards the cost of the project “*Promoting the Principles of Managing for Development Results – Furthering the Regional Integration Process*” and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this grant to eligible payments under contracts procured under this Project.

Payments by CDB will be made only at the request of the CARICOM Secretariat and, upon approval by CDB, and will be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement. The Grant Agreement prohibits withdrawal from the financing account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of CDB, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than CARICOM Secretariat shall derive any rights from the Grant Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the Grant.

The services of Results Based Management Consultants will be procured under the Project during the period September 2015 to January 2016.

Consultants from the member countries of CDB will be eligible to participate in this procurement opportunity.
